

THE CUSTOM SHOPPE

QUICK SET-UP GUIDE

TOOLS NEEDED

- Utility knife
- Philips screwdriver
- 5mm Allen wrench
- Tape measure
- Staple puller (or pliers)
- Claw hammer/Rubber mallet
- Cordless drill (drill bits and driver tips with magnetic extension)



1. UNWRAP

Remove packaging materials.

TIP: Cut stretch wrap on back of cabinet carefully to avoid damaging the finished wood.

Remove the adjustable shelves, hardware bag and all loose components.



2. REMOVE THE SHIPPING SKIDS

Lay the cabinet on its back and remove shipping skids. Remove any remaining staples.

TIP: adding plastic glides to the base of the cabinet will allow it to slide more easily during final installation.



3. ADJUST LEVELERS

Install levelers so they are flush with the bottom of the case. Raise or lower levelers to adjust.

Carefully return cabinets to upright position

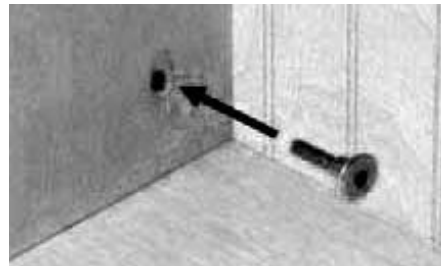
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4. CABINET SEQUENCE

Stage cabinets (for groupings)

Identify cabinet sequence numbers and arrange in proper order.



5. CONNECTING BOLTS

Install connecting bolts.

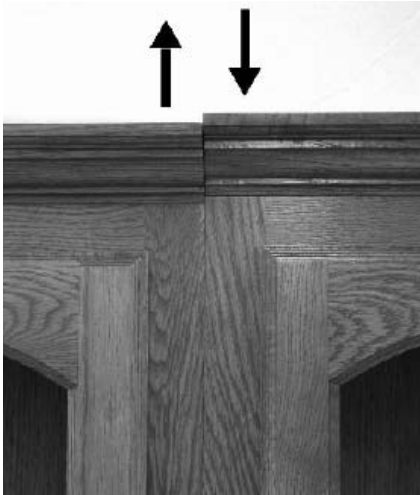
The female portion is installed at the factory. Insert male connecting bolts and hand tighten only.



6. WIRES & CORDS

Install wires and power cords. Feed cords, wires, cables, etc. through cord holes provided.

NOTE: Check for proper operation of electrical lights, etc. before proceeding.



8. MOVE & ALIGN CABINETS

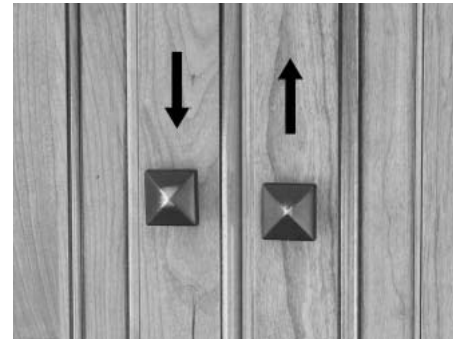
Carefully and evenly slide the cabinet(s) against the wall with a minimum of two people.

Adjust levelers to align moldings between cabinets. Wood caps are provided to cover holes.



9. CONNECT CABINETS

Double check alignment of moldings and firmly tighten connecting bolts.



10. TURN HARDWARE

Turn decorative hardware to face outward and adjust to align



11. INSTALL LOOSE COMPONENTS

Install adjustable shelves and other loose components



12. CLEAN THE CABINET

Use a high quality furniture polish to clean the inside and outside of the cabinet. Clean the glass with glass cleaner. Use a foaming glass cleaner to clean frosted glass.

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
